Stony Rockwell Touches Down

Objectives:

- To use a spatter painting technique to create specks of color.
- To express knowledge in visual form.

Advance Preparation:

- Prepare paint in containers.
- Distribute materials.

Materials:

- CHOOSE ART STUDENT BOOKLET pages 5 to 7
- White paint and containers for paint
- Paint brushes or toothbrushes

One/student of each of the following:

- Set of oil pastels or crayons
- Piece of chalk

The children will use a spatter painting technique to paint stars on their pictures. If using a paintbrush, load it with white paint, and gently but firmly flick the wrist to allow the paint to spatter onto the surface to which it is directed. If using a toothbrush, load it with paint, shake off excess paint, and then spatter the paint by rubbing a finger over the bristles. Be prepared to demonstrate to the children whichever technique they will be using. See the toothbrush spatter technique illustrated here:
