### *An Eagle's Eye*

Eagles have a very keen sense of vision—up to **eight times that of a human**. That's why we use the term “eagle-eyed” when referring to someone who notices things quickly. An eagle's head is much smaller than ours, but its eyes are about the same size.

Because their vision is so keen, eagles can see very well at a long distance. Believe it or not, **an eagle can see a squirrel from 1000 feet in the air**. We could not see the squirrel at that distance even if we were using binoculars.
