

B. A TRIP TO LOOK AT TREES

We are going to go for a walk and take a careful look at trees. Read the questions below and think about them when you are on your trip outside.



1. What colors do you see in the tree bark?

2. Do you see lines in the bark? What sort of lines are they?

3. How does the bark feel?



4. Does the bark have a smell? What does the smell remind you of?

5. Name all the colors you see in the leaves.

6. Are the leaves on the tree, or have they begun to fall to the ground?

7. Are the leaves soft and limp, or are they dry and crunchy?



8. Beginning at the trunk, follow a branch. Notice where it begins. Follow it all the way to the end. Did the big branch start from the trunk? Where do smaller branches shoot out from?



9. Notice how a leaf is joined to the tree. How is the leaf connected to the branch? Are most of the leaves joined to the trunk or to the branches?



10. Look around you. Name some of the things you see behind the trees? Are there clouds in the sky? Can you describe them?
